Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

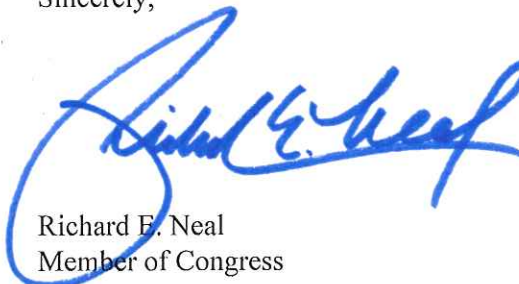
I am requesting funding for the East Springfield City Library Renovation and Expansion project in fiscal year 2026.
