Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

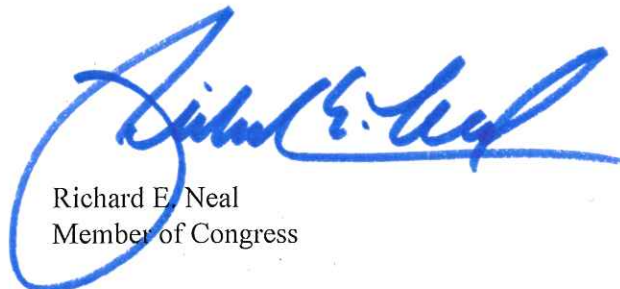
I am requesting funding for the Holyoke Farr Alpaca Mill Renovation project in fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the City of Holyoke, located at 20 Korean Veterans Plaza, Suite 406, Holyoke, MA 01040. The funding would be used for the historic preservation of these vacant mill buildings and the creation of 163 affordable homes.

This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds as this renovation will not only create new housing for low-income residents, but it will also generate hundreds of jobs and restore a blighted historical landmark, enhancing the City of Holyoke's vitality.
