Dear Chairman Cole and Ranking Member DeLauro,

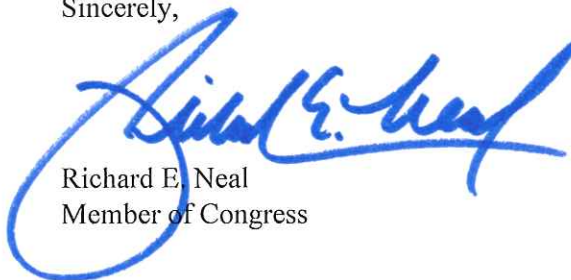
I am requesting funding for the Oxford, MA Roadway Rehabilitation on Route 12 (Main Street). The entity to receive funding for this project is the Town of Oxford, located at 325 Main Street, Oxford MA 01540. The funding would be used for reconstructing the Main Street corridor from Fairlawn Avenue to Front Street with accessible sidewalks and ramps, separated bike facilities, transit bus stops, traffic calming measures, and traffic signal upgrades at the downtown intersection.

This is an appropriate use of taxpayer funds because this reimagining of Oxford's downtown will promote multimodal travel and develop a safer, more accessible corridor for all modes and roadway users of all abilities.

The project has a federal nexus because the funding provided is for the purposes authorized by 23 U.S.C. 113.
