

I am requesting funding for the Knowledge Corridor Positive Train Control project for fiscal year 2026. The entity to receive funding for this project is the Massachusetts Department of Transportation, located at 10 Park Plaza, Suite 4160, Boston, MA 02116. The funding would be used for installing a positive Train Control system along the 49.5-mile corridor between Springfield, MA and Northfield, MA.
